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#### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

**1X Buffer R** (for 100% Bsh1236l digestion) 10 mM Tris-HCl (pH 8.5), 10 mM MgCl<sub>2</sub>, 100 mM KCl, 0.1 mg/mL BSA.

#### Incubation

37°C.

#### **Unit Definition**

One unit is defined as the amount of Bsh1236l required to digest 1  $\mu$ g lambda DNA in 1 hour at 37°C in 50  $\mu$ L of reaction buffer.

#### **Dilution**

Dilute with Dilution Buffer (#B19): 10 mM Tris-HCl (pH 7.4 at 25°C), 100 mM KCl, 1 mM EDTA, 1 mM DTT, 0.2 mg/mL BSA and 50% glycerol.

## **Double Digests**

Thermo Scientific Tango Buffer is provided to simplify buffer selection for double digests. 98% of Thermo Scientific restriction enzymes are active in a 1X or 2X concentration of Tango™ Buffer. 1X Tango Buffer: 33 mM Tris-acetate (pH 7.9 at 37°C), 10 mM magnesium acetate, 66 mM potassium acetate, 0.1 mg/mL BSA.

## **Storage Buffer**

Bsh1236l is supplied in: 10 mM Tris-HCl (pH 7.5 at 25°C), 50 mM KCl, 1 mM DTT, 0.1 mM EDTA, 0.2 mg/mL BSA and 50% glycerol.

## **Recommended Protocol for Digestion**

Add:

nuclease-free water  $16~\mu L$  10X~Buffer~R  $2~\mu L$   $DNA~(0.5-1~\mu g/\mu L)$   $1~\mu L$  Bsh1236l  $0.5-2~\mu L$ 

- Mix gently and spin down for a few seconds.
- Incubate at 37°C for 1-16 hours.

The digestion reaction may be scaled either up or down.

# **Recommended Protocol for Digestion of PCR Products Directly after Amplification**

• Add:

PCR reaction mixture 10  $\mu$ L (~0.1-0.5  $\mu$ g of DNA) nuclease-free water 18  $\mu$ L 10X Buffer R 2  $\mu$ L Bsh1236l 1-2  $\mu$ L

- Mix gently and spin down for a few seconds.
- Incubate at 37°C for 1-16 hours.

#### **Thermal Inactivation**

Bsh1236l is inactivated by incubation at 65°C for 20 min.

#### **Methylation Effect on Digestion**

Dam: never overlaps — no effect.

Dcm: never overlaps — no effect.

CpG: completely overlaps — blocked.

EcoKI: never overlaps — no effect.

EcoBI: never overlaps — no effect.

#### **Stability during Prolonged Incubation**

A minimum of 0.1 units of the enzyme is required for complete digestion of 1  $\mu g$  of lambda DNA in 16 hours at 37°C.

#### **CERTIFICATE OF ANALYSIS**

#### **Overdigestion Assay**

No detectable change in the specific fragmentation pattern is observed after a 160-fold overdigestion with Bsh1236I (10 U/µg lambda DNA x 16 hours).

### **Ligation and Recleavage (L/R) Assay**

The ligation and recleavage assay was replaced with LO test after validating experiments showed LO test ability to trace nuclease and phosphatase activities with sensitivity that is higher than L/R by a factor of 100.

### **Labeled Oligonucleotide (LO) Assay**

No detectable degradation of single-stranded or doublestranded labeled oligonucleotides occurred during incubation with 10 units of Bsh1236l for 4 hours.
